This training includes instruction in the technical knowledge and specific nursing skills that will be covered by the State Board exams. At the end of the course, graduates are issued a Proof-of-Training-Affidavit that is required to submit an application to take the State Boards. This Proof-of-Training-Affidavit is only valid for a period of 24 months, after which it expires. Most of our graduates take the State Boards approximately one month after they have completed our course. Once they pass the State Boards, the Colorado State Board of Nursing issues the "Certification" (the "C" in CNA) which remains valid as long as the persons works as a CNA and follows the renewal policies.

Tuition costs \$695 for the day course and \$595 for the evening course. The payment includes the costs for textbooks, criminal background check, drug screening, and CPR training and certification. Tuition costs \$900, which covers the full training in addition to stethoscope/BP kit, 1 set of scrubs, textbooks, gait belt, watch with second hand, tote, name badge, background check, TB skin test, urine drug test and the BLS course.

There are no prerequisites to taking the course, but candidates should possess a minimum eighth-grade reading and comprehension ability. Students must have CPR certification and current negative TB skin test in order to enter the clinical phase of the training. Students will need to submit to a drug test, and criminal background check prior to admission. The course duration runs from 8 to 10 weeks based on the student's course schedule. At \$199 per credit, the 6-credit training will cost approximately \$1,200. Students need to budget an extra \$1,500 for supplies, textbooks, background checks, medical exam, skin test, state exam fee, and CPR.
