EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES

 **265** children, parents, and caregivers received Early Childhood Mental Health supports

 **88%** of families who received Early Childhood Mental Health services or classes reported a reduction in family stress


 **1800** total children received Early Intervention, **700** of which referred from area pediatricians


 **30%** of children with developmental delays needed no further assistance after graduating from Early Intervention through TRE

 **34%** improvement in social-emotional skills in children with developmental delays who participate in the Power of Peers program for children with autism
